## SCHOOL INFORMATION

**LOCATION:** The home base of training occurs on Nellis AFB, located just 15 minutes north of the Las Vegas strip.

One of the main attractions of training in the Las Vegas desert is that it duplicates the terrain in which current Operators currently deploy. The students train in the jagged cliffs of nearby mountains and dry air of the high-desert. Add that to the 300 average days of sunshine per year, and this could be called the 'perfect' location for SOF Medic preparation.

### STUDENT PREREQUISITES:

**This school is PHYSICALLY DEMANDING! Prospective applicants will be expected to lift heavy objects, function in confined spaces, and be required to shoot/move/communicate under stressful conditions.**

Each student is expected to be PROFICIENT in safe handling and shooting with a semi-automatic pistol and M16/M4 type rifle. **Students must also be physically capable of quickly and safely assuming standing, kneeling, and prone positions, maintaining them for a period of time, in adverse conditions, and recovering without assistance.**

# SCHOOL INFORMATION

**SUCCESSFUL COURSE COMPLETION:** This is a 90+ contact hour school. *Contact hours = Actual instruction time in the classroom and on the range. It does not include travel between lodging and training site, breaks, meals and clean-up. 100% attendance is mandatory for successful school completion.* The school should be considered a full-time endeavor. It is unreasonable to expect successful completion if engaged in any additional activities during the school term.

**Gear/Weapons/Ammunition:** JTM provides a secure storage space for student weapons, ammunition and pro-gear that is brought to the school.

*ALL STUDENTS ARE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO DROP OFF THEIR EQUIPMENT THE AFTERNOON PRIOR TO EACH COURSE START DATE FROM 1500-1600 HRS. DROP OFF LOCATION: JTM TRAINING BUILDING, AREA 2, NELLIS AFB, NV 89191.*

**Student Attire:** During all classroom sessions, relaxed business attire is recommended. For the firing range / field environment, please bring uniforms & footwear appropriate for a desert climate. *IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT STUDENTS BRING AN EXPENDIBLE UNIFORM THAT CAN BE DISCARDED AT THE END OF THE CLASS.*

**Food/Lunches:** Approximately 30 minutes will be given each day to eat lunch in the training building. Student refrigerators and microwaves are available for use. Sodas, sports drinks & bottled water are available for purchase.

**Administrative needs:** JTM must receive a completed application from each student prior to arrival. (Refer to the [www.jtmlasvegas.com](http://www.jtmlasvegas.com) website)

***Current, non-expired DoD identification cards or Government Issued credentials will be required upon arrival.***

**Tuition:** Students must bring their method of payment with them on the first day of training, unless prepayment of the course had been arranged. Detailed receipts will be provided.

**Cancellation Policy:** No-show applicants will be invoiced for 100% of the course tuition. All cancellations within 14 days of course start date are subject to full payment for tuition of said course (substitutions for cancelled slots will be allowed without penalty). For cancellations within 15-29 days of course start date, students will be invoiced for 100% of the course tuition. ½ of the student tuition will be credited towards a future class date (to be used within 6 months of cancellation and only for the listed applicant.) Cancellations or reschedules made on or before 30 days of course start date are without penalty.

# CURRICULUM

This comprehensive block of training meets all of the certification requirements for the Nat'l Registry of EMT's **Basic, Intermediate or Paramedic**. Students do not need any additional training or continuing education hours for the recertification period.

**Classroom: Approximately 50 contact hours will be spent in the classroom. Subjects will include, but not limited to:**

- Basic Life Support/CPR-HCP
- Pharmacology
- Standard medications
- Extended care transport
- Non-traumatic abdomen
- Tactical Combat Casualty Care
- Triage/CCP
- Weapons of Mass Destruction
- Environmental injuries
- Allergic reactions
- Ocular injuries
- Pre-hospital Trauma Life Support
- Patrol Medicine
- Advanced Cardiac Life Support
- Pediatric Advanced Life Support

**Skills Labs/TCCC scenarios: Approximately 25 hours will be spent performing hands-on skills during our 'labs' and TCCC based training scenarios. Subjects will include, but not limited to:**

- Human cadaver lab
- Confined space extraction
- Combat Search & Rescue
- Motor vehicle extraction
- High-angle rope access
- Military Operations in Urban Terrain
- Care over the barricade
- Care Under Fire
- Tactical Field Care
- CASEVAC
- Exfiltration problems
- Convoy operations
- Teamwork in problem solving

**Range: Approximately 15 contact hours will be spent on the weapons training ranges. Subjects will include, but not limited to:**

- Weapons Safety
- Weapon Manipulation
- Marksmanship
- Combat mindset
- Team maneuver
- Field evacuation
- Communication
- Roles/responsibilities

# EMT RECERTIFICATION

(Basic, Intermediate or Paramedic)

Upon class completion, we will provide **ALL** necessary paperwork for successful recertification to include BLS/CPR, ACLS, PHTLS, and PALS/PEPP. If required, all Nat'l Registry Skill and CME sheets will be endorsed by our medical director.

**BLS/CPR-Health Care Provider:** Certification cards will be presented at the completion of this school. All requirements for Basic Life Support/CPR are included, and all necessary paperwork is signed by the EMS Coordinator and Medical Director.

**ACLS:** Certification cards will be presented at the completion of this school. All requirements for Advanced Cardiac Life Support are included, and all necessary paperwork is signed by the EMS Coordinator and Medical Director.

**PHTLS:** Certification cards will be presented at the completion of this school. All requirements for PHTLS/Military are included, and all necessary paperwork is signed by the EMS Coordinator and Medical Director.

**TACTICAL COMBAT CASUALTY CARE (TCCC):** The most current equipment and techniques approved by US SOCOM are implemented in this curriculum. Updates and initial course information will be provided.

**PALS:** Certification cards will be presented at the completion of this school. All requirements for Pediatric Advanced Life Support are included, and all necessary paperwork is signed by the EMS Coordinator and Medical Director.

Students will be given a large envelope at the conclusion of the course containing ALL certifications, CME's, Skills and other requirements of Nat'l Registry of EMT. Students will be expected to maintain and submit their own packages to Nat'l Registry of EMT's upon return to their home station.

# STUDENT EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

## **Mandatory Minimum Equipment Needs (Individual):**

- Operational medical kit (Schedule 2 Meds not necessary)
- Individual First Aid Kit/IFAK/Blow-Out Kit containing the following:
  - (1 ea) SOF approved tourniquet (SOF-T, CAT, etc)
  - NPA
  - Chest Decompression Needle
  - Chest Seal
  - Bandages as needed
- \*M4 Carbine or equivalent w/sling & optional sighting systems
- Magazine pouches for 5.56 magazines
- (4 ea) Carbine magazines (minimum)
- (1) Operational field uniform
- (1) Pair of pants and long sleeve shirt that will get damaged/stained
- Load bearing vest or equivalent
- Night Vision Device and Helmet mount
- Inter-team Radio w/battery charger (MBTR, etc)
- Global Positioning System (GPS)
- High Quality Tactical Flashlight
- Ballistic 'wraparound' eye protection (clear and dark)
- Knee and elbow pads
- Hydration system
- Sun block
- Hat/Gloves

## **Highly Suggested Equipment Needs (Individual):**

- Athletic Cup/Groin Protection & Mouth Piece
- Replacement expendable medical equipment (Tourniquets, NPA's, IV set-ups, etc)
- Signaling device (VS-17 panel, strobe, etc)
- Chemlites
- Body armor
- Clothing and footwear appropriate for the season and desert environment
- Electronic hearing protection

## **Ammunition Requirements (Individual):**

- 1000 rounds 5.56 caliber (frangible 5.56 is preferred)

**Pistols are not** needed for this course, but may be brought.

**\*JTM has a limited number of M4's available for student use with prior arrangements. There is no charge for weapon use with purchase of ammo package.**

**\*\*Ammunition for this training course may be purchased directly from JTM.**

## **Equipment / Skills Preparation**

1. **Technically Inspect Firearms and Condition of Equipment:** Have the Unit's authorized armorer conduct a technical inspection of the firearms being brought to the school to ensure the firearms are safe to fire, functioning reliably with the ammunition to be used, and that the sight system is solidly attached and functioning properly. Also, check the condition of ALL equipment you will be bringing to the school. JTM provides no personnel or facilities to repair firearms.

2. **Practice:** Practice with the firearms and equipment to be used at the school. This practice will help ensure successful completion of the school and that everything is working properly.

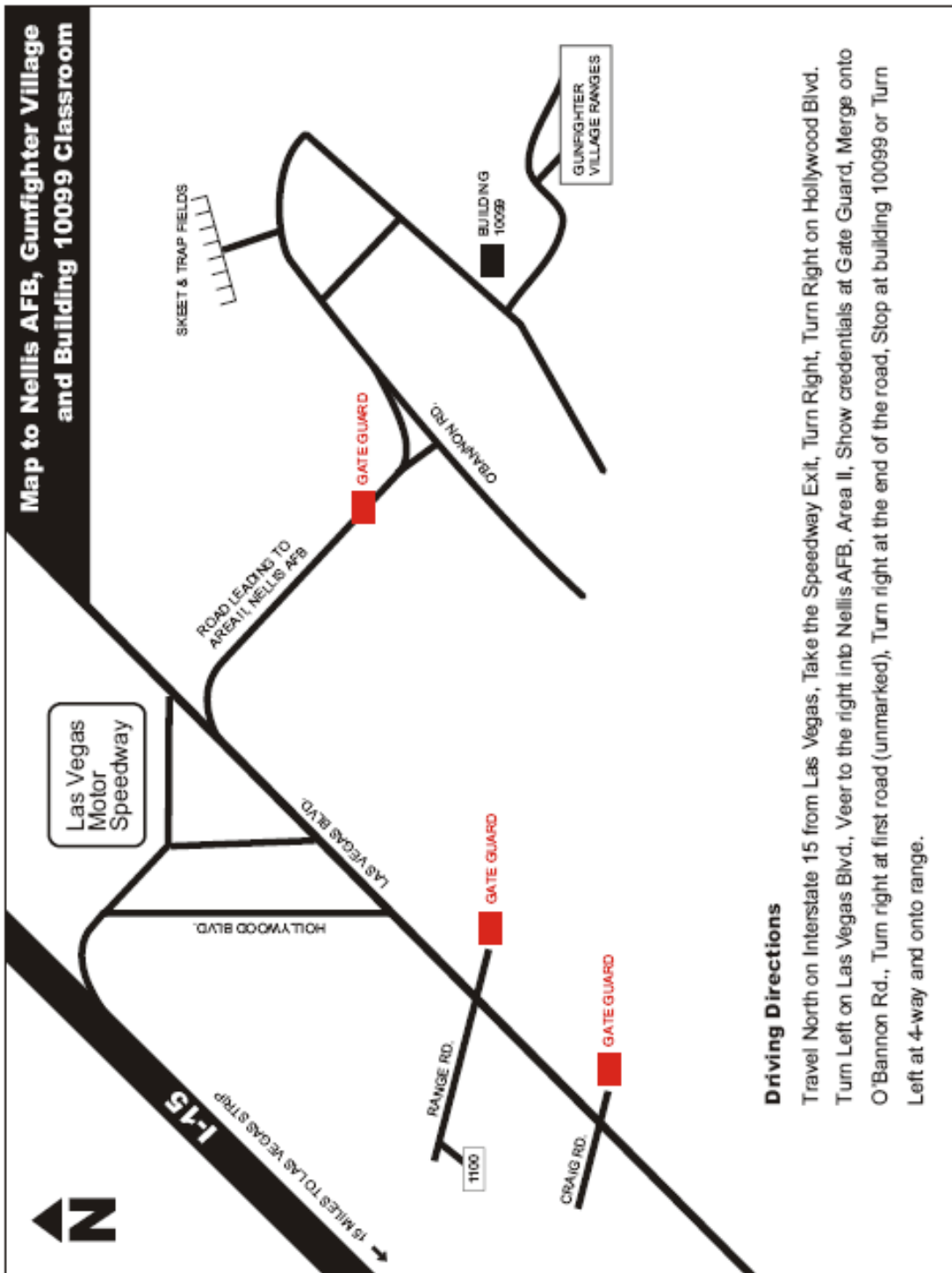
